As members of the Unitarian Universalist Association and as religious communities whose heritage and values draw from the same sources of liberal religion, we recognize it is to our mutual benefit, as well as to the benefit of our Unitarian Universalist tradition, to care about one another's well-being and to support our respective efforts to serve life's larger good.

Toward that end we covenant to grow a relationship that values cooperation, seeks mutual health and appreciates our differing communal gifts. Recognizing that as our respective religious communities develop and as our relationship evolves, our capacities to benefit one another will change, but in this moment we make these specific pledges:

OUUC will print ASUUC Adult Education classes in our Adult Education Prospectus;
OUUC will invite ASUUC youth to participate in our youth group and to participate in youth focused activities;

ASUUC will invite OUUC to join us at the Gay Pride Booth on Pride Sunday in June;
ASUUC will invite OUUC to join us in our outreach to Military Families;

Both congregations will inform one another of any special events or programs they are holding that may be of interest to their respective communities;

Designated leaders from both congregations will meet regularly to exchange information about developments in their respective communities, evaluate their recent interactions, and consider new areas of potential cooperation.
